#### **MPD-2041: ONLINE PUBLIC CONSULTATION WITH Residents and RWAs FROM GROUP HOUSING COLONIES IN DELHI**

Delhi Development Authority (DDA) in association with The National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA), is preparing the next Master Plan of Delhi 2041 (MPD-2041). As part of the process, a series of discussions and consultations have been carried out with various stakeholders and civil society groups to seek inputs from the people of Delhi that will help drive the agenda for the Master Plan. In the coming month, meetings have been scheduled with Residents from RWAs of Delhi.

**The third meeting is with Residents and RWAs from Group Housing Colonies (including DDA group housing colonies, cooperative group housing colonies and employer housing) in Delhi NCT on Wednesday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2020 from 11am onwards.** The objective of this meeting is to understand the issues faced by residents living in group housing colonies and discuss possible planning solutions. Some examples of group housing colonies in Delhi include Mayur Vihar (all phases), Tara Apartments, Yamuna Apartments, Press Enclave, Alaknanda, Vasant Kunj, Sheikh Sarai, Dwarka, Rohini, Vikas Puri, Sukhdev Vihar, Paschim Vihar and group housing colonies in IP extension such as Samachar Apartments, Ashirwad Apartments etc.
